Exalting nature, celebrating the human body, and praising the senses and sexual love, the monumental work was condemned as immoral. Whitman continued evolving Leaves of Grass despite the controversy, growing his influential work decades after its first appearance by adding new poems with each new printing. This edition presents the original twelve poems from Whitman s premier 1855 publication of Leaves of Grass. Included are some of the greatest poems of modern times: Song of Myself, I Sing the Body Electric, and There Was a Child Went Forth, works that continue toupset conventional notions of beauty and originality even today.
