

Tappan, State Commissioner of Common Schools, introduced the subject of Township Supervision, and was followed by Hon. N. H. Albaugh, of Tadmor. The discussion was further participated in by Messrs. R. H. Holbrook, of Lebanon, Arthur Powell, of Wadsworth, N. H. Albaugh, A. A. Bartow, of Sandusky, E. H. Webb, of North Fairfield, and U. T. Curran, of Sandusky.
